## Taking Action for Afterschool

- The House LHHS bill was released last month, with the potential for devastating cuts: Making your voice heard is especially important as the bills being discussed now will likely be a foundation for future negotiations later this year. <u>Friends of afterschool can weigh in with their members of Congress</u> about the importance of funding afterschool and summer learning programs and the potential impact of devastating program freezes, eliminations, and cuts that would be felt in communities nationwide.

#### Wisconsin News& Legislative Updates:

- Big changes to Wisconsin Child Care Subsidy Program (Wisconsin Shares): In July 2024, significant changes to the Wisconsin Shares childcare subsidy program were implemented. The initial income eligibility limit was increased to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), and the copayment calculation for families earning above this threshold was adjusted, adding \$1 for every \$5 increase in income.
